Attendees will receive a hands-on tutorial for using FreeConferenceCall.com (FCC) for both presentational sessions, where presenters' screens are the prominent visual component, as well as interactive videoconferences for working meetings, where webcams in a gallery view are the prominent visual component.

Screenshots of downloading the FCC app and the tools for using it to conduct various types of meeting will be featured.

How to use FCC for virtual meetings ranging from simple conference calls to hybrid multimedia productions that integrate pre-recorded material with live participant audiovisual participation will be demonstrated.

Turning to video production, attendees will hear directly from six D/5 members who contributed recurring segments as on-camera talent and videographers for "America's Boating Channel LIVE."

How you can get started producing high-definition videos with high-fidelity audio tracks by simply using the built-in camera and mic in your smartphone, tablet, or laptop computer.
