Every five years the standards for providing CPR are reviewed and updated by the International Liaison Committee on Resuscitation (ILCOR) and published by the American Heart Association (AHA). On Wednesday, October 21, 2020, the new standards will be published online in the AHA's flagship journal, *Circulation*.

On Monday, November 5, 2018, the AHA released the 2018 Focused Updates to the 2015 AHA Guidelines for CPR and ECC.

This seminar will present the changes established in 2018 and those that will be implemented in 2021. It is

not a replacement for CPR training. It is designed to focus on what has changed since you have last taken a CPR class and why you should renew your CPR certification.

All CPR courses, regardless of the organization presenting the course (i.e. Red Cross, ASHI, local Fire Dept, etc.) follow the AHA guidelines.
